

The Real ID Checklist

WHAT DOCUMENTS DO YOU NEED TO BRING?



1.) PROOF OF IDENTITY

To apply for a REAL ID card, you must present ONE original or certified copy of an identity document (no photocopies) that includes your date of birth and your true full name (first, middle, and last). Note: Driver's License is NOT a valid form of documentation.

2.) PROOF OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER

You must also present ONE original (no photocopies) document that shows your name and full Social Security Number (SSN) (if eligible). Make sure your document is up to date and accurate to avoid delay.



3.) TWO PROOFS OF RESIDENCY



You must present two original documents (no photocopies) that contain your California mailing address. BOTH documents must show the applicant's first and last name and the same mailing address that is listed on the driver license or identification card application.

4.) FILL OUT THE REQUIRED FORM AT THE DMV

When you visit the DMV, get the required form and fill it out according to its instructions. Note: Each state's DMV will have a different form for the ID.



5.) PAY THE REQUIRED FEES FOR THE ID

The fee varies by state, so check with yours to find out what you will have to pay. Bring cash, a check, or a debit card to pay the fee when you submit your application.



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
